Landscape Update

The main entrance to our neighborhood just had a lovely upgrade. Many thanks to Carolyn Maas (www.carolynmaas.com) on Walden Way, who created the new design, supervised its installation and made major funding contributions to complete the project.

New nutrient rich soil was added to the beds. New plantings include Purple Diamond Loropetalum, Christmas Jewel Holly, Cinnamon Girl Distylium, Baby Gem, Mystic Spires Salvia, Red Gerber Daisies, Blue Buddleia - butterfly bush, and Indian Feather whirling Butterflies Hawthorne.

Though these are all perennials, the design has space to add seasonal color/annuals. New edging was installed and

all was topped with Hardwood bark mulch.

It was installed so that plants will have adequate space for growth, require minimal trimming and should look great for years to come. With the new fountain lighting installed last month, this new landscaping look certainly upgrades the entrance to our neighborhood!

There are many flavors and special ones are highlighted from time to time, and the current flavor being focused upon is Black Raspberry Chocolate Chip. You can choose from cups, cones, sundaes, concretes, shakes, etc.

Although there are many locations, the one closest to our community is in Carrollton at 1733 E. Hebron Parkway (972-394-7555). This is a drive-through or walk-up location only. Don't be disappointed if you see a long line of cars; the order taking process is very organized, and the line moves quickly. The hours of operation are Sunday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m., and 11 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.

Important Changes to the Yard of the Month Program

Calloway's recently informed us they have changed their neighbor yard recognition program. **They are only funding four \$25 gift cards per neighborhood this year** (\$100); down from eighteen (\$450) in the past.
