Improving service to Dallas residents is a priority for the Dallas Police Department (DPD). To make the reporting of non-emergency crimes easier and more convenient, DPD has created an online reporting system that is available 24 hours per day.

ONLINE REPORTING PROCESS

- Go to dallaspolice.net. Click on "FILE A POLICE REPORT ONLINE." Select the type of offense you want to report. Fill out and submit the report.
- Once the report is submitted, you will get an e-mail confirming it has been submitted along with a tracking number. The report will be reviewed and an e-mail will be sent notifying you of its status:
 - Approved - You will receive a second email with a copy of the official report and case number.
 - Follow up - You will receive a second email with a request to make changes to the report, and 30 days to make any corrections.
 - Rejected - The submitted report is either a duplicate or did not meet the requirements for a crime.

- Accident (If Police Did Not Respond)
 - Burglary Coin Machine
 - Burglary Motor Vehicle
 - Credit/Debit Card Abuse
- Criminal Mischief - (Damage Under \$2500)
- Graffiti - (Damage Under \$2500)
- Harassing Phone Call
- Identity Theft
- Lost Property
- Reckless Damage
- Theft (Under \$2500)
- Theft of Service (Under \$2500)
- Theft (Shoplift Under \$2500)
