Timberglen Park Improvements Update

Here's a summary of an email we received from the Dallas Park Department in October: "... I don't have any precise date for you yet, as our Program managers are still in the process of putting together schedules. I have told them this is a high priority project and I would like to get it advertised just as soon as possible. If I had to guess, I would say it is a good bet this project will probably be advertised sometime right after the first of the year, but again, that's a guess. November and December are generally worthless because of the holidays and the fact the Park Board and Council are not in session much during those months. After bids come in, it takes between 4 and 5 months to actually award the contract (as it has to go to both the Park Board and City Council). After that, as I said, I anticipate this project will take 8 to 10 months to actually construct." Once we receive additional information and the schedule from the City, we will relay this information to all MMVHOA members by our Community Yahoo Email Group.

Crime Prevention and other Tips

During the holidays, window shopping takes on a whole new meaning. A holiday tree prominently displayed in the front window, complete with holiday gifts, makes for great window shopping for burglars.

Open Garage Doors. Not only property to steal, but tools to use for this and future burglaries such as ladders, hammers, saws, drills, etc.

Ask someone you know and trust to keep an eye on your house when you go out of town. Stop delivery of your mail and newspapers or have a friend or neighbor pick them up for you. It's also a good idea to put some inside lights on a timer. Outside motion lights are good too.

Check your smoke detectors at least twice a year and change the batteries if needed.

Park your car in your garage; at least 95% of our criminal incidents involves vehicles parked either on the street or in driveways.

Mosquitos can go from egg to adult in 7 to 10 days. Especially with the recent West Nile Virus scare, check your property for any place where water collects; in containers like garbage cans, bird baths, toys, cans and jars, flowerpot saucers, clogged gutters, old tires. Also, eliminate puddles caused by leaking faucets and pipes or condensation from air conditioners.

Remember...there is a 15 MPH Speed Limit in all alleys. Watch out for cars backing down from their driveway or coming around a corner.

Let's Talk Trash

On October 9th, our President Mike Fernandes and our Secretary) Chief Jesse Reyes reported that Dallas has had a decrease in crime for Laura Kimberly attended a meeting of the North Dallas Neighborhood Alliance which the MMVHOA is a member. The speakers at the meeting were from the Sanitation Collection Department, Neighborhood Code Department, and the North Central Dallas Police Department. Here is some interesting information from that meeting:

Homeowners are responsible for maintaining the middle of the alley to their home including keeping tree heights with 15 feet clearance and bushes away from the alley to allow access by large trucks. The Sanitation Department says their large trucks often damage trees, and the branches of untrimmed trees damage their trucks. This is a city code violation and you could receive a citation.

Your trash and recycle containers should be two feet apart to allow the automated trash truck enough clearance to grab and lift your trash container. If you need a replacement container, just call 311. To avoid litter on your lawn or in the alley, it is best to put your trash in bags, especially paper that has been shredded. Blue Recycle Bags are available at all Recreation Centers.

The Code Department is constantly checking for homeowners whose sprinklers are watering on the wrong days and on yard sales. Make sure you are watering on the correct days and that you are following the Yard Sale rules. Go to www.dallascityhall.com for this information.

It was stressed that residents should call 911 for Emergencies Only and call 311 to report all other issues or concerns to the City. This includes Lost Dogs and Cats, Street Lights that are out, wild animals you see like coyotes, raccoons, possums, etc.
