# **Timberglen Park Construction**

We received a recent update from the Dallas Parks Department – "We will be advertising the project for construction bids around the first of March. Allowing a couple of weeks for bids to be submitted by the contractors, then the Park Board and City Council will chose and award the contract for construction. It is estimated that construction might start in late May or early June. These are only estimates, because sometimes it can take a longer (or shorter) amount of time to cycle through the process".

Last June, it was explained to us that the initial plan of two soccer fields, an improved baseball/softball field, two new parking lots, a walking trail with lighting, and a six foot black vinyl coated chain-link fence from Summerfield Drive to White River Drive has a projected cost of \$1.4 million dollars. This is \$300,000 over the budget of \$1.1 million. They gave us four options for reducing the overall cost unless a contractor is willing to do the entire project for \$1.1 million during the bidding process. Those of us who were in attendance, except one resident, agreed to the following priorities:

- 1. Keep the fence with a double-swing gate at White River Drive and a single-swing gate at the north end of Summerfield Drive. The White River Drive gate cannot be locked per the City of Dallas and Oncor. We can put a lock on the Summerfield Drive gate if we wish. The total cost for the fence and gates is estimated at \$31,000.
- 2. Keep a walking trail (without lights) from White River Drive to Midway Road (no cost estimate as this was decided at the meeting)
- 3. Eliminate one soccer field (closest to Belton Drive) including the grading and irrigation and retain the current grassy area. This would save an estimated \$160,000.
- 4. Eliminate the new East Parking Lot with 43 parking spaces. This would save an estimated \$88,000. The new West Parking lot with 59 parking spaces would be retained.

The city officials feel that items #1 and #2 have a good chance of being included in the final project. What items will be included in the construction will depend on the bids submitted by the contractors. We will keep all paid members of the MMVHOA updated through our Community Yahoo Email Group.

\$1,390.37 - City of Dallas - \$782.14 and TXU Energy - \$608.23 for water and electricity at the Midway Road entrance

\$2,578.73 - Design, printing, and mailing of four quarterly newsletters

\$300.00 - Yard of the Month Gift Certificates

\$61.13 - Office Supplies, Board Meeting Supplies and Expenses

\$234.80 - Website Hosting

\$35.00 - North Dallas Neighborhood Alliance Membership

\$356.31 – Neighborhood Party Expenses

\$100.00 - Holiday Decorations

Our new Fountain that was installed last year had total expenses for the fountain and installation of \$8,732.13.

- The Dallas Animal Services & Adoption Center Rapid Response Line is 214-670-FAST. You can call this number if you see a stray animal in our neighborhood.
- Mandatory Watering Restrictions are still in effect and are permanent. If the last digit of your address ends in even numbers (0,2,4,6,8) you are allowed to water on Sundays and Thursdays only. If the last digit of your address ends in odd numbers (1,3,5,7,9), you are allowed to water on Saturdays and Wednesdays.



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
